#### Craft #1

This is a craft that the kids can do on their own at home to give their moms for Mother's Day! Find some paper. Cut the paper into 3 strips. On each strip, write something nice that you could do for your mom or let your mom do. These are your coupons to give her. Some examples could be "One free hug from me!" or "I'll clean my room without complaining!" or "You get to pick the family movie!". After you make as many coupons as you want, decorate them with fun colors! Make sure to sign your name on them! The kids will be thinking of nice things they can do for their mom. Make sure you tell the kids to thank their mom and tell her how loved she is! Ask them to share some pictures of the kid giving the coupons to the mom.

#### Craft #2

Fold some paper into a small book. On each page, write something you love about your mom! Make sure to draw a picture to go with it! Try to write at least 10 things! Then, give your book a title. You could say "10 reasons I love my mom!" Make sure to sign your name! This gets the kids thinking kind thoughts about their mom and lets them use creativity! Make sure the kids tell their mom thank you! Have the kids share pics if they did it.
